URISA-OC is proud to announce the student bursary for post-secondary students studying in geospatial fields. This is an opportunity for students to be recognized in the field of GIS.

To be considered for this bursary, students are required to submit an article detailing a GIS project or application that they have worked on during their studies. This can be an individual or group project. The URISA-OC Board of Directors will review the submissions and publish the four best submissions in one of our newsletters.

In addition, the best-of-the-best submissions will be reviewed and a \$500 bursary will be awarded to the top submission at the Annual General Meeting planned each May.

URISA-OC will also offer a complimentary one year student membership to the first 10 submissions.

This is a great opportunity for students to get name recognition and begin participating within the URISA-OC organization. URISA-OC offers solid networking opportunities for the post educational job search and many different levels of involvement as part of a diverse community of geospatial professionals.

Articles should be no longer than 1,000 words and include a description of the project, its purpose and the solution that it will provide. Deadline is Feb 28th each year.
